Also, keep in mind these simple guidelines:

- You must be at least 8 years old to bring your bike along.
- Loading and securing the bike onto the rack is your responsibility. Bus Operators are not permitted to assist you and bikes cannot be locked onto the rack.
- Only single-seat, two wheel bicycles are allowed. Motor-powered vehicles, bikes smaller than 16" and bikes with covered spokes are not permitted.
