


Do butterflies and flowers need water to live? Do you?

# Be A Dear and Conserve our water




Without water,

*Deer use water to drink or swim. People use water to drink, swim, bathe, clean, brush teeth, grow plants, cook, fight fires, and much more!*




Why is it better to wash your car on the lawn instead of the driveway? Draw a boy helping to wash the car.

*If you wash your car on the lawn, you are watering the grass at the same time!*







TURN OFF THE SPRINKLERS IN THE RAIN!




Running sprinklers in the rain is a huge waste of water!

# 10 Water Saving Tips

*Saving water is a blast!*

**Share these ideas  
with your family!**

- 1 Take shorter showers (5 minutes or less) or shallower baths.
- 2 Turn the water off when you are brushing your teeth or washing your face.
- 3 Don't flush bugs, trash, or chemicals down the toilet.
- 4 Use a hose with a shut-off nozzle to wash vehicles and pets.
- 5 Fix leaks and drips, especially in the kitchen or the bathroom.
- 6 Install water-saving shower heads, faucets, and toilets.
- 7 Use a broom to clean sidewalks or driveways rather than a hose.
- 8 Wash full (not half-empty) loads in the dishwasher and washing machine.
- 9 Water your lawn with well-aimed sprinklers, and use reclaimed water if it's available.
- 10 Encourage your friends and family to use water wisely!
